ghost-writing for Sarah
Allgood; Geert Lernout
discovers the source for
Yeats's 'Tulka', Günther
Schmigalle unearths his
surprising connexions with
American communist colonists
in Virginia, while Deirdre
Toomey edits some new
letters to the French
anarchist, Auguste
Hamon—all providing new
annotation for standard
editions. The volume is
rounded with review essays
by Colin McDowell (on *A
Vision*, and Berkeley, Hone
and Yeats), shorter reviews of
current studies by Michael
Edwards, Jad Adams and
